## Directive 2011/65/EC - RoHS2 (ex 2002/95/EC)

IBOCO confirms that most of our products, mainly used as components for fixed electrical systems, do not fall within the scope and are not included in the categories listed in the RoHS and in the related WEEE (2002/96/EC) Directives.

In any case, our policy, as far as the RoHS Directive came into force, is to have all our products strictly in compliance with the Regulation and with all of its subsequent amendments, in order to cover those applications in which our products are used as components of electric and electronic equipment (EEE) covered by the Directive. In this case, the manufacturer of the final EEE will be fully responsible for compliance of the equipment in which our products are integrated.

Therefore, we declare that the products included into our 2017, 2018 and 2021/2022 pricelist reserved to you do not contain any substances banned by the above mentioned Directive.

Compliance has been achieved on the basis of the analysis of the material safety data sheets and written statements of exemption from our suppliers of raw materials and components.
